General Meeting Agenda

1. Call to order

The meeting was called to order by Schan Hill.

2. Approval of Feb, 2008 general meeting minutes

Meeting minutes were approved with the addition of information pertaining to the Rules Committee presenting recommended rules changes to all members present at the February meeting. Meeting minutes were approved as amended.

3. Financial report-Keith Reynolds

Keith Reynolds presented the financial report. Current balance is \$3147.12.

4. Old business

No old business was discussed.

5. New business

A. Additional rules

Brock Reynolds made a motion from the floor to allow the association members to vote on two additional Rules Committee recommendations that were not included on the March ballot by Executive Committee decision. The motion was seconded and the floor was opened for discussion. After a period of discussion, a vote was held and by majority the motion passed. The additional rules will be voted on at the April 2008 meeting, to allow time to publish notification to the membership.

6. Other business

Four rules changes were voted on as presented by the 2008 Rules Committee. The floor was opened for discussion on each ballot item, with anyone present given time to present information regarding the item. Ballots were counted with everyone present and results presented as follows:

1. Should the CYFA have a weight limit in all leagues?

\* NOTE. If this passes, ALL leagues will have weight limits. If this does not pass, NO leagues will have weight limits. Weight limits will be determined by the Executive Committee after further review, if weight limits are implemented by this vote.

2. Omit the following rule from the CYFA By-Laws: "The Association will supply the game ball for all official games." and replace with the following: "Each team will be responsible for furnishing their own game ball."

3. Eliminate the wording in the By-Laws on page 6, item #2 that defines the lock priority clause (defining automatic locks) and replace with wording that simply states that each team has three locks.

4. Clarify in the By-Laws a rule already enforced: "If a returning player chooses NOT to return to the same team, he must return to the draft and he cannot go to another team as a lock or be chosen in the lock catch up round.

\* NOTE. The By-Laws are already interpreted this way, this will simply clean up the wording.
