General Meeting Minutes

August 2011

1. Call to Order

2. Approval of Minutes

The July 2011 Minutes was submitted by George Crumbly for approval. Motion to accept by Dan Davis and seconded by Dusty Sutterfield, passed by a vote of 6-0.

3. Financial Report

The Financial Report was submitted by Dusty Sutterfield. The checking account balance is currently \$30,642.02 with a difference of \$22,875.46. The first down payment on the uniforms has been made. Motion to accept by made by George Crumbly and seconded by Dan Davis. Motion was passed by a vote of 6-0.

4. Old Business

- A. Sponsor checks. As of this meeting we are currently 5 teams short on sponsorships.
- B. Signs. We need to bring in all signs that are currently out.
- C. Schan has spoken with Parks & Recreation and the new athletic director and CYFA will be able to use the high school football field.

5. New Business

- A. Registration numbers. There are currently 342 kids signed up to play football having 418 last year. Schan asked members present to call kids that are not currently registered reminding them of the last night of registration (Thursday August 18, 2011).

- B. Skills & Drills Camp. Gary spoke with members present about camp this Friday night at the fields. There are 160 kids registered bringing in an additional \$4,000 to the CYFA. The same type of camp used last year will be used again this year with 6 stations. Members of the local semi-pro team Sabres will be assisting with the camp. We need volunteers bringing cones, footballs dummies, ice chest with ice. The CYFA will furnish the water.
- C. Schan asked CYFA members present if they would be available for the final registration on Thursday August 18th. He asked volunteers to see George about signing up to work the registration.
- D. Dan explained registration numbers thus far: 63 Mini Campers (6 teams of 10 players); 100 Rookies (8 teams of 12 players); 119 Semi Pro (9 teams of 13); and 59 Pro (5 teams of 12).
- E. Saturday's Draft. The board discussed the draft Saturday August 20, 2011 at the High School football field. After each league completes the skills portion of the draft the coaches will move to the conference room of the recreational center where they will complete the draft. Schan opened the floor for coaches to ask questions with several questions asked regarding CYFA rules.
- F. Schan explained first week practice schedules with no contact. Teams can practice as many days as they want to however there can only be three (3) contact practices per week, this includes games. He asked coaches to make an effort to avoid practicing on Wednesday's and Sunday's.
- G. Guest Gary Bulice spoke to the members on training kids for football.

6. Adjournment

George Crumbly made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Thomas Modica Seconded, passed by a 6-0 vote. The meeting was adjourned by CYFA President Schan Hill.
